PARADE STARTS AT 8:00PM SHARP

Arrive to the staging location between 6:30pm -7:30pm

STAGING LOCATION: Wool Bowl at 1716 Grand Avenue

Lineup will be in the parking lot of the Wool Bowl at 1716 N. Grand Avenue. Enter on to the Wool Bowl off of the Garden Avenue entrance on the East. Travel West in the parking lot. You will receive a float number and parade volunteers wearing **Yellow reflective vests** will assist you in lining up.

PARADE ROUTE: Parade starts at 1716 N. Grand Avenue, heads South on Grand Avenue, turns West (right) on to College Avenue & left on to Main Street. Parade will travel down Main Street then turn left on to 3rd Street. Floats may disburse off of Virginia Avenue or meet their parties at the Billy Ray parking lot.

Landing location: After the parade meet your party at the parking lot of Billy Ray's, 113 E. 3rd Street or continue either North or South on Virginia Avenue.

PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING RULES TO AVOID DISQUALIFICATION FROM THE PARADE

1. ABSOLUTELY NO STOPPING ALONG PARADE ROUTE – KEEP MOVING.
2. Absolutely no candy or other items will be thrown or dropped from the float or vehicle.
3. Getting on and off vehicles or floats is STRICTLY prohibited.
4. No loud noises, including but not limited to revving engines, burnouts, backfiring and offensively loud or inappropriate music.
5. Fire extinguisher must be on the vehicle or float.
6. All parade entrants must obey law enforcement directions – Roswell Police Department or Chaves County Sheriff's Department
7. Neither MainStreet Roswell, the UFO Light Parade nor the City of Roswell will be held responsible for any accident or injury resulting from the parade.
